Along with UC Berkeley, UCSD has the second highest graduation rate in the UC system.

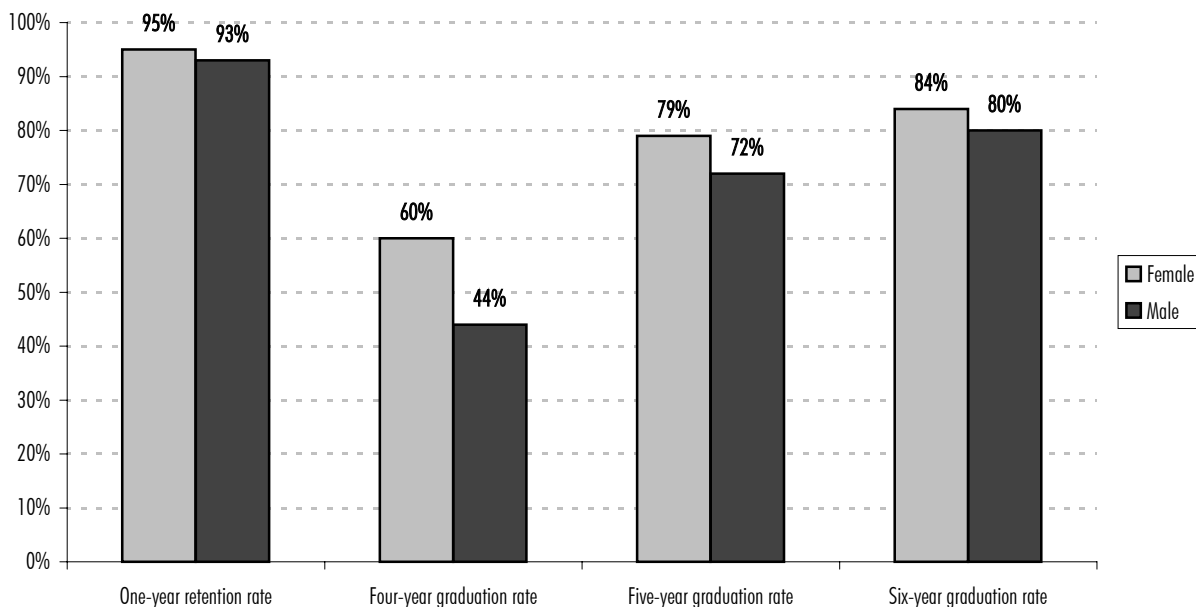

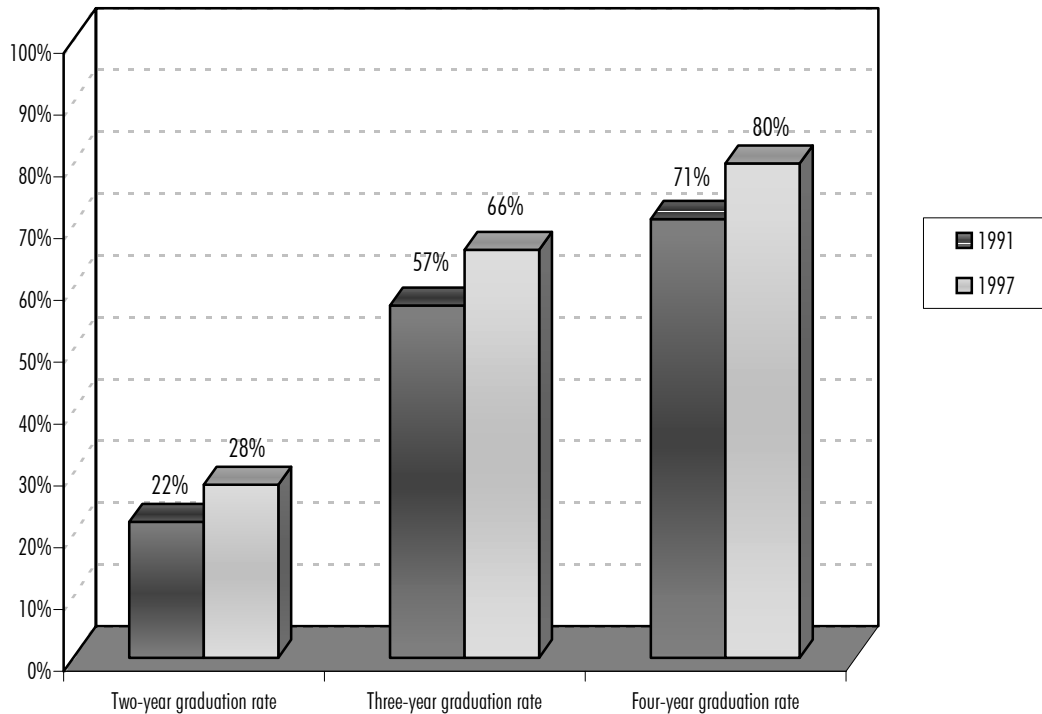
